


Grooming Tools & How to Groom

Curry Combs



A







Use curry comb to loosen the dirt and hair.

Use on muscled areas in a circular motion.





Hard Brush

Use on muscled areas to remove dirt and hair loosened by curry comb

Use in the direction the hair grows Use a flicking motion



Hard Brush












When using the hard and soft brushes follow the direction of the arrows below.





Use all over the horse's body.

Follow the direction that the hair grows.

Use in a flicking motion.







Pick up hoof and support hoof with one hand while picking out dirt with the other hand.

Repeat with each hoof to remove dirt, stones and debris.

Mane and Tail Combs











Comb mane in downward direction to remove all tangles






Comb Tail

Spray tail with detangler & let dry.

Hold tail in one hand and stand to the side of the horse.

Start combing at the bottom of the tail and slowly work your way up.

Try your best not to pull any tail hairs out!





Finishing Touch (optional)

Use a medium to small towel.

Soak in hot water then ring out well.

Use towel all over horse in the direction the horse's hair grows to remove all surface dirt.
