



How to Bang a Tail



What is a Banged Tail?

A banged tail has been trimmed straight across the bottom. It should be cut just above the hind fetlock.



Why Bang a Tail?

Traditionally horse's tails were banged to avoid them becoming soiled and straggly at the bottom. Some tails get so long that they will drag on the ground.

How to Bang the Horse's Tail

Spray tail with detangler then let dry.

Carefully comb tail so as not to pull any hairs out.

Comb through entire tail.



Then gather up entire tail in one hand at the bottom where you want to make the cut.

Using the trimmers or scissors cut straight across below your hand.
